Kay Gastinger did his Master degree in 1997 within Electrical Engineering at the Technical University of Ilmenau (Germany). He joined SINTEF in Norway in 1997 as a Research Scientist. In 2006 he received his PhD in Physics within Optics from the University of Oldenburg (Germany). From 2007 Kay was working as a Senior Scientist in SINTEF department for Optical Metrology. In 2010 he became the director of NTNU NanoLab. In this position he is responsible for operation of the cleanroom infrastructure and for coordination of nanotechnology research at NTNU. Kay is also leader of the national infrastructure NorFab, the Norwegian Infrastructure for Micro- and Nanofabrication. The infrastructure projects received a funding of about 11M€ over a 5-years period from the Research Council of Norway.
