He is a Distinguished Professor in the Department of Engineering Science at National Cheng Kung University, Tainan, Taiwan. His main research interests include bio-MEMS, microfluidic systems and nanotechnology in biomedical applications. He is currently the Vice President of Conferences of IEEE Sensors Council, a senior editor of the Journal of Micro/Nanolithography, MEMS, and MOEMS, an associate editor of IEEE Sensors Journal, and an editorial board member of Journal of Micromechanics and Microengineering. He was elected as a Fellow of the Royal Society of Chemistry in 2008, a Fellow of the International Society for Optics and Photonics (SPIE) in 2012, and a Fellow of the Institution of Engineering and Technology (IET) in 2013.
